

D2000 Event Handler

The process Event Handler is the administrator of all objects of **Event** type. Events are objects of D2000 system, which provide facilities to handle system events (incidents). The process provides for starting and execution of events. Event Handler has no desktop for interaction with user.

The process includes the check of continuous request processing. In normal conditions, a request must be processed within a few seconds. If the check finds out that a request is being processed longer than defined timeout, the process **D2000 Event Handler** will be terminated and the file *event.log* will contain the following log:

Time out job : 1001. Description : *activity description* time out = 120 [s]
Terminate process

where:

activity description - activity performed by the process

120 - timeout [s] defined by the start parameter [/FI](#)

If the timeout is not defined, its default value is [/FI120](#).
