

References to objects of Historical value type

According to the type of [historical value](#), references are defined as follows:

- for **simple historical value** - name of the object of [Historical value](#) type
- for **one-column historical value** - name of the object of [Historical value](#) type along with a row index. In ESL, a row index must be enclosed between square brackets (e.g. *H.ColArchiv[2]* (*H.ColArchiv\HBJ,2,0*))
- for **structured historical value** - name of the object of [Historical value](#) type along with a row index and a column name. List of columns is given by an object of [Structure definition](#) type, that defines the structure of the historical value. In ESL, such a reference is similar to the reference to an item of [Structured variable](#) type object (e.g. *H.Struct[2]^ColName* (*H.Struct\HBJ,2,3*)).
