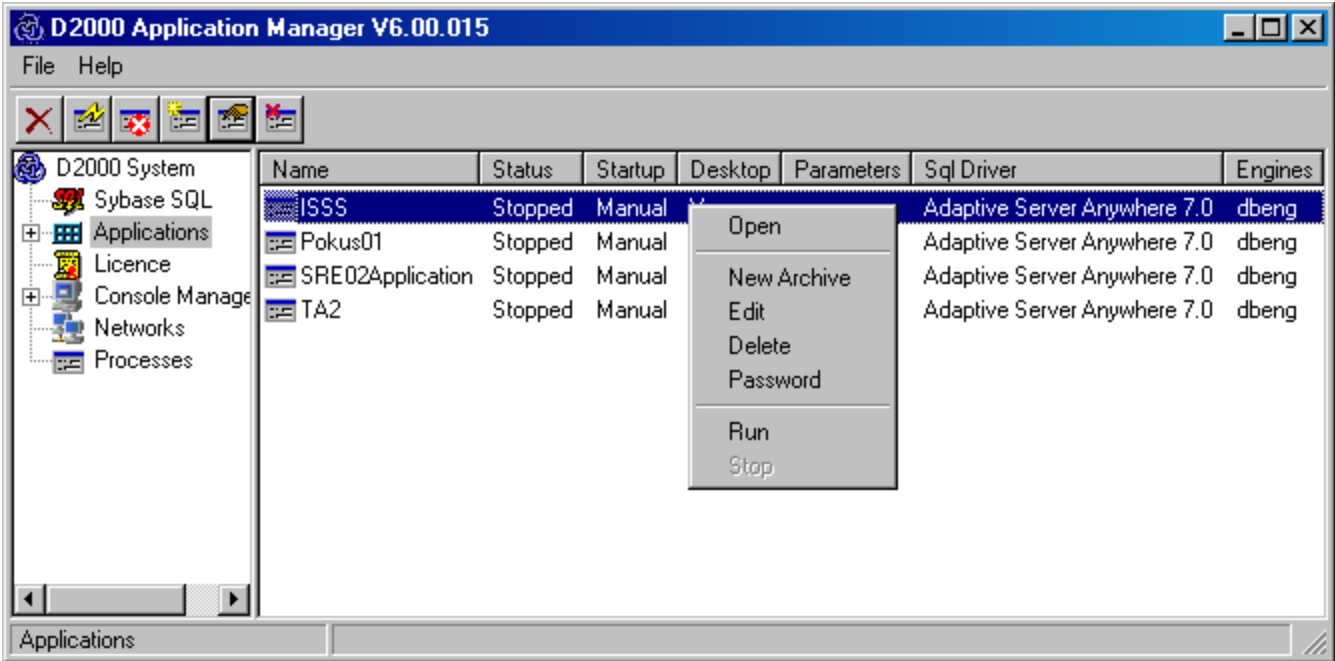


# Management of D2000 Applications

D2000 system applications are managed by the [D2000 Application Manager](#) (*d2smc.exe*) tool.

By application management of the D2000 System we mean:

- [Creating a new application](#)
- [Editing the selected application](#)
- Starting the application
- Stopping the application
- Deleting the application
- [Creating a new archive](#)
- [Editing an existing archive](#)
- [Setting parameters for the D2000 Server process](#)
- [Setting parameters for the archive](#)



When you select **Applications**, a list of applications configured on this computer will appear in the right part of the window. The meaning of the individual columns of the list is as follows:

<b>Name</b>	Name of the application
<b>Status</b>	Status of the application ( <i>Stopped, Running, Pending...</i> )
<b>Startup</b>	Method how to start the application service
<b>Desktop</b>	If Yes, process D2Start and <a href="#">D2000 Server</a> will be visible on the desktop
<b>Parameters</b>	List of parameters that are given further at process start <a href="#">D2000 Server</a>
<b>SQL Driver</b>	Driver for database operations
<b>Engines</b>	List of servers that are necessary for the application to run and whose functionality will be monitored by the D2Start process

**Note:** The application launcher is the D2Start process, which supervises the [D2000 Server](#) and Database Servers process. If D2Start detects that the [D2000 Server](#) process stops abnormally, it will try to restart it.
