## %HI\_HistoryStart function

**Function** The function activates the [picture history mode](#) from script specifying the required time period.

**Declaration**

```
%HI_HistoryStart(  
    TIME in _bt,  
    TIME in _et  
    INT  in _step := 0  
)
```


**Parameters**

<b>_bt</b>	Beginning of time interval.
<b>_et</b>	End of time interval.
<b>_step</b>	Optional parameter. Time step for resampling of values in an archive.

**Description** The function activates the picture history start from script in required time period. When entering a time step, data will be resampled in archive.  
If the picture is in history mode, the input times will be used as a new required interval. The changes of connection to the objects of D2000 are not acceptable after the history has been started.

Picture history mode can be exited by calling [%Hi\\_HistoryEnd](#).
