Function %HI_SetDraggable enable / disable a possibility to move particular object in picture.

```
%HI_SetDraggable(  
    INT in refId,  
    BOOL in _onoff,  
    INT in _moveType,  
    BOOL in _visible  
)
```

refId	Reference to displayer (reference variable).
_onoff	Enable / disable the possibility to move object.
_moveType	<div>If the parameter is:<ul style="list-style-type: none">0 - it allows moving only on X-axis1 - it allows moving only on Y-axis2 - it allows moving on X-axis and Y-axisother number - the function will be ignored</div>
_visible	Enable / disable a visibility of object (@True = the object is visible, @False = the object is invisible).

```
%HI_SetDraggable(_LINE, @TRUE, 2, @TRUE)
```
