Function

Declaration

The function cancels the zoom used for given axis in displayer of [Graph](#) or [XY Graph](#) types.

```
%HI_ResetGraphZoom(  
    INT in refId,  
    BOOL in bResetX,  
    BOOL in bResetY,  
)
```

Parameters

refId	Reference to displayer (reference variable).
bResetX	Cancels the zoom used on the X-axis (time zoom). Possible values: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• @TRUE - cancel the zoom• @FALSE - no change
bResetY	Cancels the zoom used on Y-axis (value zoom). Possible values: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• @TRUE - cancel the zoom• @FALSE - no change

Example

```
%HI_ResetGraphZoom(_Graph, @TRUE, @FALSE)
```

The function cancels the zoom used on X-axis ([time zoom](#)) and the zoom on Y-axis (if used) remains unchanged.
