%StrToHBJ function

Function

The function returns the unique identifier (HOBJ) of the system object given by its name.

Declaration

```
HBJ%StrToHBJ(  
    TEXT in objName  
)
```

Parameters

objName	Text expression.
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Description

The function sends a query to the process [D2000 Server](#) to detect the unique identifier of the system object defined by the parameter *objName*. If the object doesn't exist or the parameter is an invalid value, the function returns invalid value.

Example

```
INT _hobj  
  
_hobj := %StrToHBJ("Sec")  
IF _hobj # Sec\HBJ THEN  
    ; error (condition must not be met)  
_hobj := 0  
ENDIF
```

In the example, the object's HOBj is detected in two ways.
