

HBJToStr

%HBJToStr function

Function

The function returns the name of the D2000 system object specified by its unique identifier (HOBJ).

Declaration

```
TEXT %HBJToStr(  
    HBJ in objID  
)
```

Parameters

objID	Value of HBJ or INT types.
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Description

The function sends a query to the process [D2000 Server](#) to detect the name of the D2000 system object defined by the parameter *objID*. If the object doesn't exist or the parameter is an invalid value, the function returns invalid value.

Example

```
INT _hbj  
TEXT _name  
  
; HOBJ of the object Sec  
_hbj := %StrToHBJ("Sec")  
  
_name := %HBJToStr(_hbj) ; variable _name will contain the value of Sec  
_name := %HBJToStr(Sec\HBJ) ; variable _name will contain the value of  
Sec, too  
  
; object probably doesn't exist => _hbj is invalid value  
_hbj := %StrToHBJ("qwerty")
```
