

SubStr

%SubStr function

Function

The function returns a subtext from the string given by the index of the first character and a number of characters.

Declaration

```
TEXT %SubStr(  
    TEXT in Text,  
    INT in idxFrom,  
    INT in numChars  
)
```

Parameters

text	Text string.
idxFrom	Index of the first character in text string (from 1...).
numChars	Number of characters in result string.

Example

```
%SubStr("some text", 2, 3)      ; returns the following text : "some"
```

If the value of the parameter *idxFrom* overruns the string length, the function returns invalid value. If *numChars* is greater than admissible number of characters, the text is to be cut off:

```
%SubStr("some text", 2, 100)     ; returns the following text : "some text"
```
