Assigning a selection of objects to logical groups

Objects can be assigned to logical groups either individually (during their configuration) or as a group, i.e. several objects together.

- 1. Open the selection window in process D2000 CNF.
- 2. In the object list, select the objects you want to assign to logical groups.
- Click the button Assign the object(s) to logical groups.

The dialog box contains the tree structure of all logical groups defined in the application. The checkbox in front of a name of each logical group inform us what kind of operation is to be executed for the object selected in the selection window in regard to logical groups.
