
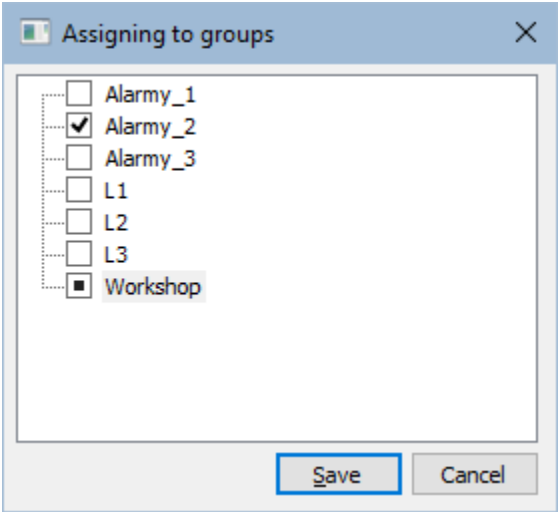


Assign a Selection of Objects to Logical Groups

Assigning a selection of objects to logical groups

Objects can be assigned to logical groups either individually (during their configuration) or as a group, i.e. several objects together.

- 1. Open the [selection window](#) in process [D2000 CNF](#).
- 2. In the object list, select the objects you want to assign to logical groups.
- 3. Click the button  - Assign the object(s) to logical groups.
- 4. The following dialog box will appear:



The dialog box contains the tree structure of all logical groups defined in the application. The checkbox in front of a name of each logical group inform us what kind of operation is to be executed for the object selected in the selection window in regard to logical groups.

To change a membership of the selected object, click on the proper logical group, or select particular group and click on a button with the proper symbol.
