Example

Get object at index from JSON array.

```
INT %JSON_ArrayGetObject(  
    INT in handle,  
    INT in index  
)
```

handle	Handle to parent JSON array.
index	Index of object

Handle to JSON object, must be released by [%JSON_FreeObjectHandle](#).

Function get object at index from JSON array.

Exception is thrown if object at index is not object, handle to JSON array is invalid or index is out of range.

```
INT _arr  
_arr := %JSON_ArrayFromString( '[{"Name": "John"}]' )  
  
INT _obj  
_obj := %JSON_ArrayGetObject(_arr, 1)  
  
%JSON_FreeObjectHandle(_obj)  
%JSON_FreeArrayHandle(_arr)
```
