Function	The function returns the RGB value of given color.

Description	The function returns the value of required color, that is defined by the parameters <i>page</i> (1 up to 10 in the color palette), <i>row</i> (1 up to 8 on given page in the color palette) and <i>column</i> (1 up to 16, "A" up to "P" or "a" up to "p" on given page in the color palette).						
Note	The column can be defined either by number 1 up to 16 or single letter text "A" up to "P", or "a" up to "p". These forms of record are equivalent, i.e. 1 is the same as "A" (or "a"). The function %MakeRGB allows to form the color from individual color components.
