## %HI\_GetPalRGB function

### Function

The function returns the RGB value of given color.

### Declaration

```
INT %HI_GetPalRGB(
    INT in page,
    INT in row,
    INT in column
)
```

```
INT %HI_GetPalRGB(
    INT in page,
    INT in row,
    TEXT in column
)
```

### Parameters

<b>page</b>	Page of the color palette.
<b>row</b>	Row on the page of the color palette.
<b>column</b>	Column on the page of the color palette.

### Description

The function returns the value of required color, that is defined by the parameters *page* (1 up to 10 in the [color palette](#)), *row* (1 up to 8 on given page in the [color palette](#)) and *column* (1 up to 16, "A" up to "P" or "a" up to "p" on given page in the [color palette](#)).

### Note

The column can be defined either by number 1 up to 16 or single letter text "A" up to "P", or "a" up to "p". These forms of record are equivalent, i.e. 1 is the same as "A" (or "a"). The function [%MakeRGB](#) allows to form the color from individual color components.
