Function	<p>The function %HI_SetVisible allows to hide/show the graphic object (Control function).</p> <p>The function %HI_GetVisible detects whether the graphic object is visible.</p>

Description	The function also allows to show / hide a tab of Windows control of Tab control type - the parameter <i>refId</i> determines the reference variable name of the tab.
