%JSON_ObjectIsObject function

Function

Checks if there is an object in a given field in the JSON object.

Declaration

```
BOOL %JSON_ObjectIsObject(  
    INT in handle,  
    TEXT in field  
)
```

Parameters

| | |
|---------------|-------------------------------|
| handle | Handle to parent JSON object. |
| field | Field name |

Return value

@TRUE if in given field is object, else @FALSE.

Description

Function checks if there is an object in a given field in the JSON object.

Exception is thrown if handle to JSON object is invalid or field does not exists.

Example

```
INT _obj  
_obj := %JSON_ObjectFromString(ModuleInfo)  
  
BOOL _is_object  
_is_object := %JSON_ObjectIsObject(_obj, "client_info")  
  
%JSON_FreeObjectHandle(_obj)
```
