%HI_GetActiveTab function

Function

The function detects the active tab of the Windows control of [Tab control](#) type.

Declaration

```
INT %HI_GetActiveTab(  
    INT in _TAB_refId  
)
```

Parameters

`_TAB_refId` Reference ([reference variable](#)) of Windows control of [Tab control](#) type.

Note

The function retrieves the reference variable of the selected tab. If the tab has no reference variable, the return value is 0.

Example

The procedure `HideActiveTab` hides the active tab:

```
; _TAB_CONTROL - reference variable of Windows control of "Tab control"  
type  
  
PROCEDURE HideActiveTab  
INT _ActiveTabRefId  
_ActiveTabRefId := %HI_GetActiveTab(_TAB_CONTROL)  
%HI_SetVisible(_ActiveTabRefId, @FALSE)  
END HideActiveTab
```
