

# Value Representation Methods

## Value representation methods in the D2000 System

The displaying of object values in pictures is described in the topic of [Connecting graphic objects to view](#).

The following alternatives in the listed order are to be used to display the object values, not in pictures (e.g. Browser in the [D2000 HI](#) process, control windows, current values in graphs, etc.):

1. There will be displayed [Status text](#), if it is defined for the displayed value.
2. There will be displayed [System text](#), if it is defined for the given value or object attribute.
3. The value will be displayed by the [Transformation palette](#) if a palette is defined.
4. There will be used default displaying, which is trying to display the object value with maximal accuracy.
