


# Log On to Server


## D2000 System Console - log on to the server

To view the output of a server and control it, you must log on to the server. The logon dialog box is opened after right-mouse clicking the server name in the [list of redundant groups, servers and processes](#) and selecting the item **Connect** from the open [menu](#).
