    BOOL in _onoff,  
    INT in _moveType,  
    BOOL in _visible  
)
```

| refId | Reference to displayer (reference variable). |
| _onoff | Enables/disables the possibility to move an object. |
| _moveType | <div>If the parameter is:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 0 - it allows moving only on X-axis• 1 - it allows moving only on Y-axis• 2 - it allows moving on X-axis and Y-axis• other number - the function will be ignored</div> |
| _visible | Enables/disables the visibility of an object (@True = the object is visible, @False = the object is invisible). |

%HI_SetDraggable(_LINE, @TRUE, 2, @TRUE)
```
