%HI_PrintGO function

Function

The function prints a picture part - a display of [Graph](#) or [Picture](#) types ([Control function](#)).

Declaration

```
%HI_PrintGO(  
    INT in refId  
    BOOL in bPreview := @TRUE  
    [, BOOL in bDescriptTable])  
)
```

Parameters

refId	Reference to a display of Graph or Picture types (reference variable).
bPreview	Show/hide the "Preview" dialog box before print.
bDescriptTable	<p>The parameter is used only for printing a display of Graph type. Possible values:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• @TRUE - print the graph table• @FALSE - don't print the graph table <p>When the parameter is not entered, the table will be printed only if it is shown in the graph window.</p>

Description

The function prints the display of [Graph](#) or [Picture](#) types defined by the reference variable *refId*. If the parameter *bPreview* is not entered ,or its value is @TRUE, there is displayed the "Preview" dialog box before print.
If the parameter value @FALSE print will continue without any user's interactions.
