

# Grouping

## Graphic object grouping

Grouping graphic objects allow to create the groups of graphic objects. You can work with them as if they were a single graphic object. The mutual relations within the group are not changing.

You can carry out the following operations with the group of graphic objects:

- to move the group within the picture,
- to resize the group - it also resizes the graphic objects of the group (text sizes are not changing),
- to integrate it to another group.

### Note relating to D2000 Thin Client
