Application Name	Name of the new application	
Appl. Description	Application description, which can be used in printouts.	
DB Driver	Driver to access the database, supported are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Sybase SQL AnywherePostgreSQLSQL Server	
Engine Name	When the Sybase SQL Anywhere or PostgreSQL driver is selected, a menu of configured database servers is displayed	
Path for executable	The path to the D2Start application, including the parameters that are given to the D2000 Server process	
Startup	How to start the application:	
	Automatic	The application starts up when the operating system starts
	Manual	The application must be started manually through the D2SMC process
	Disable	Application startup is disabled

It is only possible to change the application name and database driver when configuring a new application. If it is a modification of an existing one, these fields will be disabled.
