

External and user libraries in Java

External and user libraries are saved on the server in subdirectories of directory *<appldir>/java/shared*. This directory is replicated automatically to all computers that the client processes of the D2000 are running on and which uses Java script.

The replication is done after the client ([D2000 GrEditor](#), [D2000 CNF](#), [D2000 HI](#), [D2000 EventHandler](#), TTS) has been started. It is the automatic copying of files from a directory placed on the server to the computer with a running client. A synchronization will make a copy of both directory structure and files 1:1.

Warning: The files/directories, that are not on the server, will be deleted on the client computer.

If some change has been done in directory *<appldir>/java/shared*, the user must send the TELL command [DEPLOY_JAVA_SHARED](#) to the server. Tell command will ensure that the [D2000 Server](#) will send these changed files to all running clients.
